KCAI does not provide health insurance for students.

Health Insurance Guidelines for International Students

The Kansas City Art Institute requires all international students to be covered under the following minimum level of health insurance:

- USD \$50,000 medical benefits
- USD \$10,000 repatriation of mortal remains
- USD \$10,000 emergency medical evacuation
- The plan may not hold a deductible higher than USD \$500

Students must provide the Primary Designated School Official (PDSO) or Designated School Official (DSO) with proof of current health insurance coverage and must maintain coverage throughout the entirety of their enrollment at KCAI. Students who fail to submit proof of insurance coverage or fail to keep it current, may jeopardize their enrollment.
